## **IMPORTANT NOTES**

- 1. Rubber material may appear dull grey rather than black. This is normal and is easily rectified by cleaning.
- 2. Always store the material flat to avoid it taking on an abnormal shape.
- 3. All material is supplied in stock lengths of 9'-10".
- 4. Material must reach 65°F minimum to 75°F maximum 24 hours prior to installation. This is essential to minimize the expansion and contraction of the material.
- 5. When cutting the industrial bumper sections, CS recommends using an 80-100 tooth carbide tipped saw blade or equivalent to minimize tearing and maintain joint alignment. Care must be taken when cutting, as rubber materials have a tendency to snag.
- 6. When field forming radius bumpers, be sure to apply needed pressure across length of guard.
- 7. Do not over tighten fasteners as they could strip or cross-thread which would result in bumper not being fastened to the wall properly.
- 8. Splice joints can simply be butt jointed.
- 9. Clean products of any obvious dirty marks using mild detergent and water.
