Care and Maintenance

Storage

1. Protect materials from physical damage. It is best to keep them stored in their original crating and packaging in a dry, well-ventilated location free from dirt and debris.
2. Store materials to allow for inspection and measurement of quantity and size units.
3. Handling of the materials shall be kept to a minimum.

Handling / Maintenance

CS Facade Solutions and Architectural Screens (further known as “system”) are virtually maintenance free. To maintain the appearance and structural integrity of the item, the following procedures should be performed at least once per year, or more frequently if needed.

1. Visually inspect the system for any apparent defects, loose fasteners, etc.
2. Remove any debris that may have accumulated on the system.
3. Rinse the system with clean water.
4. Using a non-abrasive device, wash the system with a mild soapy mixture and rinse with clean water.
5. Inspect all fasteners. Check the recommended torque settings on the bolt and nut connections that fasten the system to the mounting brackets. Reference the CS shop drawings for the recommended torque.
6. For Screenwall Systems – inspect all fasteners and tighten all clip connections. If weather proofing or caulking was used to seal splice connections, those areas should be evaluated and/or replaced yearly, or as recommended by the sealant manufacturer.
