

Please read these instructions thoroughly prior to beginning the **HC-75C** installation!


This instruction sheet is intended to provide a specific guide to follow for the installation of the **HC-75C.** Contained within is the technical information and installation techniques required to complete an efficient, neat, and long-lasting installation.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Layout the work and spot check the material for any damage that may have occurred during shipping and/or handling at the jobsite. Always store the material flat to avoid creating kinks.
- 2. Take measurements of the corner to be protected and, if necessary, cut the corner guard to length.
- 3. Drill the corner guard max 2" [50.8mm] from edge and 12" [304.8mm] max on center. Reference Chart below for dill diameters
- 4. If the unit is not fitted floor to ceiling, the exposed end should be sealed with black sealant.
- 5. Remove the protective film and clean product of any obvious dirty marks using mild detergent and water.
