

# Read through all instructions prior to starting installation.

#### 1. Sub Floor and Floor Preparation

- Control temperature: 65° F. Ambient, relative humidity: 10% 65%. Slab cannot be less than 65° for at least 48 hours after installation.
- All holes, cracks and depressions must be filled with latex underlayment and eliminated.
- Concrete must be fully cured, clean, dry, smooth and free of debris or any other material that would prevent a good bond.
  Primers not recommended.
- Ongrade concrete sub floors must be free of hydrostatic pressure.
- It is the responsibility of the flooring contractor to determine the dryness of all concrete sub floors before installation.

#### 2. Be sure area is properly ventilated.

**3. Install frames if applicable (see framing options on page 2).** Install frames around perimeter of carpeting. Secure with supplied fasteners or double-sided tape.

#### 4. Apply adhesive using one of the following methods.

- 1/16" notch trowel with a spread rate of approximately 139 square feet per gallon.
- Nap roller with a spread rate of approximately 250 square feet per gallon.

**5. Keep the applied adhesive free of dust.** You may install carpet when adhesive has turned from milky white to clear and will not transfer to touch.

### 6. Carpet Installation

- Install tiles in aesthetic layout or pattern as described the by the end user
- Complete by trimming all the perimeter carpeting flush with the inside of the perimeter aluminum framing or wall with utility knife or carpet knife.
- Use straight edge to ensure clean, straight cut.

### 7. Cleanup and Storage

- Clean up accidental spills on face of carpet or other surfaces by blotting or wiping with a wet cloth before adhesive dries.
- Use all-purpose safety solvent for dried adhesive.
- Soak tools in water and peel or use solvent.
- Store in cool, dry place and close container tightly after each use.

# **Care and Maintenance**

1. Vacuum a minimum of once daily with a commercial grade vacuum.

2. DesignStep should be periodically deep-cleaned by the hot water extraction method. Construction Specialties recommends a minimum quarterly extraction cleaning for high-traffic applications and more periodic cleaning during the winter months in traffic lanes.

3. Spot Removal: if a spill occurs, use a clean, absorbent cloth or paper towel to absorb as much liquid as possible. Blot from edge of spot to center to prevent from spreading. Spray the stained area with an all-purpose spot remover and rub the surface with a clean, white cloth. Grease or oil-based stains may require a citrus-solvent based spot remover. Always test spot removers on an inconspicuous area of the mat.
